DEVELOPER'S CORNER

Pecan Square is going strong. We have over 1,100 occupied homes and over 1,250 home sales. The completion of the Jackson Hall expansion that includes the second pool and the fitness center was a highlight for 2022. Elm Tower was also completed in 2022. If you want to see breathtaking sunsets, this is the best location in Pecan Square. We hope everyone is watching the progress of the Johnny Daniel Elementary which broke ground this year and will be open for the Fall 2023 school year.

New in 2023: Several new phases of development are underway with almost 500 new lots being completed in 1Q23. These new phases will resupply all the product lines (40', 50', 60' and 70') and our first section of Estate Lots (100' \times 180') will be completed. Highland, Coventry and David Weekley have new models underway that will open in 1Q23. Along with the new lots, there will be pocket parks within each section.

We are excited to announce the new amenities that will start construction in 2023 along the ridge. The north ridge, across from the elementary school, will be home to a pickleball complex. Knowing our competitive residents, we anticipate many community tournaments. Once the new pickleball complex is complete the Arena will be dedicated to basketball on the sports side. The south ridge, located south of Elm Street, will be the home of our third pool. We will share renderings with the community once we have the plans finalized.

As we hit milestones in 2023, the Management Team will share our progress. Thank you all for choosing Pecan Square to call home.
